- a. *Beat Report from California Highway Patrol in Ventura County*
 - *The California Highway Patrol (CHP) was present to deliver a report this month. Reported on DUI checkpoints, low traffic citation given – mostly warnings, responding to loud parties from 911 requests.*

 - o *The Ventura County Sheriff's Office shared updates on recent Graffiti Abatement events, provided safety tips to help prevent car theft, and emphasized the importance of community members reporting any suspicious or unusual behavior. Gold Coast District Director Vanessa Rauschenberger delivered the 2025 Annual Gold Coast Transit report to the Council and members of the community.

 - c. Receive and Fire a Presentation from County of Ventura and the City of Ventura the Saticoy Pedestrian Improvement Project and Santa Paula Branch Line Project – *Alelia Avenue Update*

Gianfranco Laurie Staff member from the County of Ventura Public Works Agency Roads and Transportation and the City of Ventura Public Works Department staff member provided an update to the Council and community members on the Santa Paula “Rails to Trails” Branch Line Project as it relates to Alelia Avenue. The update included the anticipated construction schedule as well as forthcoming notifications to residents regarding easement encroachments in the project area. Alelia Street is scheduled to undergo traffic improvement construction in 2026 as part of the City of Ventura’s grant-funded Santa Paula Rails to Trails project.
